Sealed item rate Tender is invited as detailed below on behalf of the BHOGAPURAM INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT CORPORATION LTD. (BIACL) for the work as mentioned at **Serial No.1** in Schedule E.

Sealed item rate tenders are invited by BHOGAPURAM INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT CORPORATION LTD. (BIACL), Office at 1st Floor, FDC Complex, AC Guards, Hyderabad – 500 028, INDIA on behalf of MD, BIACL from Original Equipment Manufacturers (OEMs) or Indian subsidiary of parent company of foreign OEM who have executed similar nature of work “ Supply, installation, testing and commissioning of Airfield Crash Fire Tenders (ACFTs) at Orvakal Airport, including All Inclusive Comprehensive Maintenance Contract (AICMC)” at an estimated cost of contract INR 10,00,00,000/- (INR Ten Crores (Approx.) with period of completion of 10 (Ten) Months. Tenders will be issued to the eligible applicants from **12 Jan 2018 to 11 Feb 2018**. The completed tender documents will be received till **17:00hrs on 12 Feb 2018** and shall be opened on the same day at 17.30 hrs.

The scope of work covers Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of Airfield Crash Fire Tenders (ACFTs) at Orvakal Airport, Kurnool, Andhra Pradesh, India, including All Inclusive Comprehensive Maintenance Contract (AICMC) for 5 years after the 2 years of Defects Liability Period. Annual Maintenance Services /Contract shall be carried out during the 2 years Defects Liability Period.

1. Tender forms will be issued to those firms who produce certificate from clients having satisfactorily completed at least three works each of INR 4,00,00,000/- or two works each of INR 5,50,00,000 /- or one work of INR 11,00,00,000/- of similar nature of work during the last seven years ending on 31/01/2018 (firm showing work experience certificate from Non-Government / Non PSU organization should submit “Tax deduction at source certificate” in support of their claim for having experience of stipulated value of works) and produce proof of annualized average financial turnover of INR 6,90,00,000/- during the last three years, ending on 31st March 2017. If the value of experience certificate/turnover is not in Indian rupees the amount will be converted to Indian rupees based on the conversion rate as on 31 Dec 2017. The Tenderer shall submit the documents as per the check list enclosed vide Annexure-A and consent letter as per the format enclosed vide Annexure-B. Phase/part completion of the scope of work in a contract shall not be considered.
2. Application for issue of tender document shall be submitted up to 11 Feb 2018 on all working days along with tender fee of INR 10,000/- (Non-refundable) in the form of Demand Draft drawn in favour of Bhogapuram International

Airport Corporation Limited (BIACL), payable at Vishakhapatnam. The application shall be supported with self- attested copies of client certificate for experience, indicating date of completion as per agreement and actual date of completion and completion cost of work (experience certificate should contain work order copy, price bid & completion certificate). The financial turnover should be supported with annual reports (abridged balance sheet and profit and loss account statement for last three financial years shall be submitted).

3. Consortium/Joint venture companies shall not be permitted.
4. BIACL reserves the right to accept or reject any or all application without assigning any reason.
5. If at any stage, any information/documents submitted by the applicant is found to be false, the agency shall be liable for debarment from tendering in BIACL, apart from any other appropriate / legal action.

SECTION A: GENERAL INFORMATION & GUIDELINES

1. SCOPE OF WORK

BHOGAPURAM INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT CORPORATION LTD. (BIACL) desires to get executed the work of **“Supply, installation, testing and commissioning of 02 nos of Airfield Crash Fire Tenders (ACFT) at Orvakal Airport, including All Inclusive Comprehensive Maintenance (AICMC)”** at an estimated cost of INR 10,00,00,000/- (INR Ten Crores) (Approx.) with period of completion of 10 (Ten) Months. Tenders will be issued to the eligible applicants from 12 Jan 2018 to 11 Feb 2018. The completed tender documents will be received till 17:00hrs on 12 Feb 2018 and shall be opened on the same day at 17.30 hrs.

Breakup of scope of work is as under: -

- i. Supply, installation, testing and commissioning of Airfield Crash Fire Tenders (ACFT) at Orvakal Airport, including All Inclusive Comprehensive Maintenance Contract (AICMC) including clearing and payment of customs duty for all the imported items.
- ii. Training of BIACL Engineers as well as training of Airport fire staff.
- iii. Making arrangement for payment of Freight and Insurance charges for the supply items.
- iv. Making arrangement for Inland transportation and its payment for the supply items.

- v. The Annual Maintenance Contract (AMC) & All-inclusive Comprehensive maintenance contract (AICMC) of ACFTs and associated systems which includes activities as per Para 2 &3 on page AICMC-1 to 3, for five Years after defect liability period of two years.
2. The work has to be executed as per the Price Bid, in conjunction with specifications, terms & conditions and schedule of execution, given in this tender document. The approximate estimated cost of work is mentioned at **serial no. 2 in Schedule E**.
- 3. Period of Work: -**
- The works are required to be completed within the period mentioned at serial **No.3 in Schedule E**. This period shall be reckoned from the 10th day after the date on which BIACL issues written orders/Letter of Intent to commence the work.
- 3.1 BIACL reserves the right to place orders as a whole or in parts depending upon site requirements.
4. Tenders shall be submitted in the prescribed Form.
 5. Not more than one offer shall be submitted by a manufacturer. No two or more concerns in which an individual is interested as Proprietor and/or partner shall tender for the execution of same works. If they do so, all such Tenders shall be liable for rejection.
 6. The Accepting Authority as mentioned at **serial no. 4 in Schedule E** will be the Accepting Officer, here in after referred to as such for the purpose of this contract.
 7. The offer shall be submitted at the BIACL Office, Hyderabad, not later than the date and time as mentioned at **serial No.9 in Schedule E**.
 8. Submission of a tender by a Tenderer implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the eligibility criteria, scope and specifications of the works to be done, local conditions, local market rates and other factors bearing on the execution of the works.
 9. Notification of Award of contract will be made in writing to the successful Tenderer by the Accepting Authority or his representative. The contract will normally be awarded to the qualified and responsive Tenderer offering lowest evaluated bid in conformity with the requirements of the specifications and contract documents and the Accepting Authority shall be the sole judge in this regard. The Accepting Authority does not bind himself to accept the lowest or, any tender or to give any reason for his decision.
 10. A responsive Tenderer is one who submits priced tender and accepts all terms and conditions of the specifications and contract documents.

- 11.** A major modification is one which affects in any way the quality, quantity and period of completion of the work or which limits in any way the responsibilities or liabilities of the Tenderer or any right of BIACL as required in the specifications and contract documents. Any modification in the terms and conditions of the Tender which are not acceptable to BIACL shall also be treated as a major modification.
- 12.** The Accepting Authority reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the Tender and Tenderer shall be bound to perform the same at his quoted rates.
- 13.** The Tenderer shall not be permitted to Tender for works in Orvakal Airport Engineering Department, responsible for award and execution of contracts, in which his near relative is posted as Manager Finance & Accounts or Sr. Officer or as an Engineer in any capacity. He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him who are near relatives to any officer in BIACL /Orvakal Airport. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be debarred from Tendering for next 2 Years.
- 14.** The Tenderer shall give a list of BIACL employees related to him if any.
- 15.** No Engineer equivalent to Gazetted rank or other Gazetted Officer of equivalent rank in Central/State Government Department employed in Engineering or Administration duties in Bhogapuram International Airport Corporation Ltd./Fire Department, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of two Years of his retirement from Bhogapuram International Airport Corporation Ltd./ Government service, without the previous permission of Bhogapuram International Airport Corporation Ltd./ DG-Fire Department, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the Contractor or any of his employees is found at any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of Bhogapuram International Airport Corporation Ltd./Govt. of Andhra Pradesh as aforesaid before submission of the Tender or engagement in the contractor's service.
- 16.** Tender for the work shall remain open for acceptance for a period of **180 days** from the date of opening of Tender. If any Tenderer withdraws his Tender before the said period or makes any modifications in the terms and conditions of the Tender which are not acceptable to the Department, then Bhogapuram International Airport Corporation Ltd. shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit the earnest money absolutely.
- 17.** Tenderer who will utilize the services of an Indian associate shall submit the details of the Indian Associate as per **Annexure-7**. All the payments of contract shall be payable directly to the Contractor only. No direct correspondence from Indian associate/Accredited agent shall normally be entertained by BIACL. Any

default by Indian associate/accredited agent shall be sole responsibility of contractor. In case of any lapse/violation by the Indian associate/accredited agent action shall be taken as per the terms of the agreement against the contractor only.

- 18.** The Tenderer should study the complete tender document. In order to facilitate BIACL to prepare responses, the interested Tenderers are requested to submit their queries to BIACL through email only, at least seven working days prior to the scheduled date of submission of Tender. The Tenderers queries will be replied by email only.

19. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD): -

- 19.1 The EMD amount in Indian rupees for the Tender shall be as per **serial no. 8 of Schedule- 'E'** in the form of Bank Guarantee drawn in favour of BHOGAPURAM INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT CORPORATION LTD. payable at Vishakhapatnam or in the form of a Bank Guarantee (BG) as per Form "A" from a Nationalized/scheduled bank (as per RBI schedule) having office in India, along with an undertaking as per Form "A1". Authorized representatives/Accredited agent in India of foreign Tenderers can also submit EMD in Indian rupees on behalf of their Principal Firm. Tenders not accompanied with the requisite earnest money will be rejected. In the case of any extension of tender opening date, Tenderer shall arrange to extend validity of such EMD, BG suitably. Failure to extend the EMD validity may result in encashment of EMD and further his tender may not be considered.

The Bank guarantee submitted for EMD shall be valid till validity of the tender which is **180** days from the original scheduled date of tender opening. No other means of EMD shall be accepted.

- 19.2 On acceptance of the Tender, the earnest money will be treated as part of the security deposit. The EMD of the successful Tenderer will be returned if the Tenderer furnishes the required full security deposit in the form of Bank guarantee.

- 19.3 BIACL will return the EMD where applicable to every unsuccessful Tenderer except as provided in the tender document.

- 19.4 If the successful Tenderer fails to submit the performance guarantee within 30 calendar days and fails to enter into a contract with BIACL within 15 calendar days after the date of issue of letter of acceptance of bid, then the EMD amount is liable to be forfeited, besides cancellation of contract.

- 19.5 No interest or any other expenses, whatsoever on the EMD will be payable by BIACL.

- 19.6 The Tender EMD may be forfeited in the following cases:

- i. If a Tenderer withdraws its tender during the period of tender validity specified in the tender conditions.
- ii. In the case of a successful Tenderer, if the Tenderer fails.
 - a. To sign the Contract in accordance with **Clause 19.4**.
 - b. In case of any false information/document submitted by Tenderer.

19.7 **Bid Bond:** Successful Tenderer is required to furnish a Bid Bond (**Annexure-13**) along with supporting Bank Guarantee for an amount of 10% of the total price to BIACL immediately after award but before execution of work and opening of Letter of Credit.

20. The Security Deposit and Performance Guarantee shall be as **per Para-19(A) & 19 (B) of GCC on page no. GCC 8 - 10.**

21. Procedure for quote of tender (Price Bid):

21.1 The rates quoted shall be **firm and fixed and subject to no escalation** whatsoever till the successful completion of the work except otherwise mentioned anywhere in the tender.

21.2 All rates shall be quoted in **Item wise** inclusive of all applicable taxes and duties.

22. Currency of Quote:

22.1 (i) Indian firms shall quote in Indian Rupees (INR) only for all the items in the Price Bid & the Foreign firms shall quote either in US Dollar or in Euro Only.

(ii) Cost of overseas freight, insurance and other elements, the local Transport / insurance charge in India and all-inclusive comprehensive maintenance contract (AICMC) shall be separately indicated as given in the Price Bid.

22.2 This is an item rate tender, only rates quoted shall be considered. Tenderer should quote the rates in figures as well as in words clearly. The rates quoted in figures shall be in International numerals and whole numbers. The amount for each item should be worked out and the all requisite totals given. Special care shall be taken to write rate in figures as well as in words and the amounts in figures only.

22.3 Prices quoted by the Tenderer shall be inclusive of all the taxes and duties applicable in the Country of origin and in India and the same shall be as

per the details given under the **clause No- 22 of General Conditions of Contract.**

- 22.4 Since this will be an indivisible work contract, which includes supply of items as per the Price Bid and its testing and commissioning, the Contractor is responsible for ensuring the items reach the site in good condition. The Tenderer shall survey the Rail / Road / Sea /Air route for transporting the ACFTs to Orvakal Airport.
- 22.5 **Offers without Annual maintenance contract for 2 Years during DLP, and AICMC for 5 Years after DLP (All Inclusive Comprehensive Maintenance Contract) quote are liable to be rejected.**
- 22.6 A supplementary agreement would be executed for Annual Maintenance Contract during DLP, and AICMC for 5 years after DLP as per **Form E** along with section E for Annual Maintenance Contract & All Inclusive Comprehensive Maintenance Contract (AMC/AICMC)'.
- 22.7 This is an item rate tender, only rates quoted shall be considered. Any tender quoting percentage below/above the estimated cost (percentage of tender) is liable to be rejected.

23. Power of Attorney/authorization for signing tender:

- 23.1 Only the Power of Attorney/Authorization holder of the Tenderer on whose name the tender has been issued shall sign the Tender documents. Tender signed by the Indian agent/representative shall not be considered and shall be rejected. The original of the document shall be submitted along with the Original EMD.
- 23.2 The name and designation of the person or persons of the company who is authorized to sign shall be clearly indicated in the authority letter.
- 23.3 In the event of the tender submitted by a partnership firm, it must be signed separately by each partner thereof, or in the event of the absence of any partner, it must be signed on his behalf by a person holding a Power of- Attorney authorizing him to do so by the partners. A certified copy of the Power-of-Attorney issued by the company/partnership firm shall be produced with the tender along with evidence of registration of partnership firm / company.

24. Implementation of Integrity Pact

25. Guidance For Submission Of Tender

- 25.1 The Tenderer should purchase tender document or any other details from the office of Managing Director, Bhogapuram International Airport Corporation Ltd. (BIACL), Office at 1st Floor, FDC Complex, AC Guards, Hyderabad – 500 028, INDIA
- 25.2 Tender for the present work shall be submitted to the Office of BIACL at Hyderabad. Original EMDs, other documents like Authorization for signing tender, **unconditional Acceptance Letter with an undertaking as per attached Annexure-9**, etc. along with tender documents shall be submitted to the office of Chief Executive Officer, Bhogapuram International Airport Corporation Ltd. (BIACL), at 1st Floor, FDC Complex, AC Guards, Hyderabad – 500 028, INDIA, so that it would reach before the date & time of opening of tender. The Tenderer whose EMD along with unconditional acceptance are not received by the time of opening of tender will not be opened and their tender will be summarily rejected. Any postal delay will also not be entertained/considered.
- 25.3 Rates to be quoted in items wise only.
- 25.4 The rate for individual item has to be quoted along with the Service tax component for individual items. (Service tax element to be shown separately)
- 25.5 Once the contractor has submitted the signed tender document along with unconditional acceptance, he is not permitted to submit any remark(s)/condition(s) in/along with the tender documents except unconditional rebate on quote.
- 25.6 In case the condition 25.5 above is found violated, the tender shall be rejected.
- 25.7 **The Tenderer shall submit tender documents at BIACL Office at Hyderabad only on or before the due date and time for submission of tender in the proforma as per the format (Form B) at page NIT-16. The details of the data to be submitted in respective Bid are as below.**

Technical Bid (Volume I)

It shall contain the following.

- i. Unconditional Acceptance of BIACL's finalized terms and conditions as per Form- "F".
- ii. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) in the form of Demand Draft as per proforma at Form- "A". (Ref clause 19 of NIT.)
- iii. Power of Attorney/authorization letter for signing tender document (Ref clause no.23 of NIT) as per Annexure C.
- iv. Tender documents duly filled and signed including all the undertaking/Annexure/Forms enclosed in the tender document at Section F.

- v. Tenderer's/Manufacturer's Technical details/Catalogues.
- vi. Details of Indian Associate in the proforma as per Annexure- 7 in case of foreign origin.
- vii. Under taking as per Annexure-9.
- viii. Copy of approval certificate of Steering System as per clause no 13.5 of Technical Specifications.
- ix. Copy of approval certificate of Brake System as per clause no.11.7 of Technical specification.
- x. Certificate on letter head from Engine Manufacturer regarding the emission norms as per clause no 6.1(c) of Technical Specification and suitable for operation with locally available fuel quality.
- xi. Guaranteed Technical Particulars/Questionnaire as per Annexure 11.

Price bid (Volume II): -

It shall contain the Duly filled in Price Bid. For quote of Price Bid please refer NIT clause- 21 & 22

26. PROCEDURE FOR OPENING OF TENDER

Following steps shall be followed for opening of tender documents.

- i. The Technical Bid shall be opened on scheduled tender opening date at BIACL Office, Hyderabad. If the Original EMD in the prescribed form along with other documents like Authorization for signing tender, Unconditional Acceptance Letter along with an Under taking as per Annexure-9 etc. are not submitted before the due date of submission of tender to this Office, such tender shall not be considered and liable to be rejected.
- ii. The price bid, only of those Tenderers whose Technical Bid have been accepted by BIACL, will be opened later, for which a separate communication via Email should be sent.

27. COMPARISON AND EVALUATION OF TENDER

27.1. Prior to detailed evaluation, Purchaser will determine the substantial responsiveness of Tender document. A substantial responsive Tender is one, which conforms to all the terms and conditions of the Tender.

27.2 Once the Tenderer has given unconditional acceptance to BIACL's tender conditions in its entirety, he is not permitted to put any remark(s)/condition(s) except unconditional rebate on quoted rates, if any in/along with tender enclosed in price bid. All rates shall be quoted in the price bid (Volume -II).

- 27.3 In case the condition 27.2 mentioned above is found violated after opening Technical Bid, the tender shall be summarily rejected and BIACL shall, without prejudice to any other remedy, be at liberty to forfeit the 10% of said earnest money.
- 27.4 Only those Tenderers whose Technical Bid documents are acceptable to BIACL will be examined and their techno-commercial bid shall be evaluated to determine whether they are complete, meets tender requirements, free from computational errors, whether the data have been properly filled up, and whether the requisite documents as detailed have been submitted in conformity to the Tender specifications, drawings and conditions.
- 27.5 In case Tenderer submits manufacturer's technical catalogue in the Technical Bid the same will be considered only for reference. Hence Tenderer shall fill up the technical data with due care.

28. PRICE BID: -

Price bid of only those Tenderers whose Technical Bid documents are acceptable to BIACL will be evaluated as under:

- i. The cost of routine maintenance during DLP as well as All-inclusive comprehensive maintenance cost for further 5 years shall also be taken into consideration for evaluation.
- ii. The cost which is to be reimbursed by BIACL on production of documentary proof shall not be taken into consideration for evaluation of Bids.

29. Rejection Of Tender: -

- 29.1 BHOGAPURAM INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT CORPORATION LTD. reserves the right to reject all the tenders or any of the tender or any part of tender without assigning any reason.
- 29.2 BIACL reserves the right at its sole discretion not to award any work under this tender. BIACL shall not pay any costs or loss incurred by the Tenderers in the preparation and submission of any requisite tender or technical proposal or procurement contract for any of the items described herein.
- 29.3 If the Tenderer deliberately gives wrong information or suppress any information in his Tender, BIACL reserves the right to reject such tender at any stage or to cancel the contract, if awarded, and to forfeit the Earnest Money, absolutely, in addition to any other appropriate/legal action.

- 29.4 Canvassing in any form in connection with the tenders is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by firms who resort to canvassing are liable for rejection.
- 29.5 Any deviation in the Tender submission procedure will be considered as non-responsive bid and liable to be rejected.
- 29.6 A Tenderer shall submit a responsive bid, failing which his Tender will liable for rejection.
- 29.7 Tender in which any of the particulars and prescribed information are missing or are incomplete, in any respect and/or prescribed conditions are not fulfilled, shall be considered non-responsive and is liable for rejection.
- 29.8 The Tenderer is expected to examine the tender document including all instructions, forms, terms, specifications, drawings, etc. Failure to furnish all information required as per the tender documents or submission of a tender not substantially responsive in any respect may result in the rejection of the tender.
- 29.9 The work under this tender will be in restricted to Operational/ Security areas of the Airport. BIACL reserves the right to accept or reject the tender in full or in part, if so required due to security reasons.
- 29.10 A Tenderer shall submit the tender which satisfies each and every condition laid down in this notice failing which the Tender will be liable to be rejected.
- 29.11 Any tender not accompanied with EMD in the prescribed form will not be considered.
- 29.12 a) Apart from above any entity/Tenderer (or any entity controlled by them which has been Debarred/Blacklisted by any PSUs /Govt. Departments from participation in any project within last Three years and if the debar subsists as on date of the bid, would not be eligible to submit the bid. Even if such entity participates in the bid and the same has been noticed at a later date the entity will be blacklisted as per the conditions specified in the tender documents in addition to rejecting their offer. **Under taking as per attached Annexure-10 shall be submitted.**
- b) Further the Tenderer shall ensure that all the supporting documents are submitted and all relevant details as per prescribed format in the tender documents are furnished to avoid rejection of their tender.
- 30.** The documents / data of the Tenderers accompanied in Technical Bid shall be scrutinized and processed by BIACL to ensure whether the same are in

conformity with the eligibility criteria and technical specification of the tender. It shall, therefore, be in the Tenderer's interest to give complete and comprehensive technical particulars/description and details etc. along with bid as required in Technical Bid.

- 31.** No correspondence will be entertained from the Tenderers after the opening of the tender, other than asked by BIACL for any clarification, if required by BIACL.
- 32.** The successful Tenderer on acceptance of his offer, has to submit requisite Performance Guarantee as per **GCC Clause no. – 19(B)** of the general conditions of contract within 30 days from date of issue of acceptance letter.
- 33.** BIACL shall be the sole judge in the matter of evaluating & accepting technical bids, price bids and award of contract and the decision of BIACL shall be final and binding.

35. Period of validity of tender:
